Synergies with ANYWHERE

ANYWHERE objectives:

- implement a Pan-European multi-hazard platform providing better identification of expected weather-induced impacts and their location in time and space before they occur
- empower exposed responder institutions and citizens to enhance their anticipation and pro-active capacity of response to face extreme and high-impact weather and climate events.

Potential:

- Stakeholders from responder institutions
- Institutions active on transboundary events

Synergies with PLACARD | SPINE

Inputs from PLACARD:

SPINE database:

- Excel file with **164** entities covering international, regional and national stakeholders (137) as well as their activities (27):
 - **Stakeholder tags:** brief description, core competencies, field, type, scope of work, target group, physical location of the headquarter, URL, contact person(s)
 - **Activity tags:** activity title, brief description, activity type, hazard type, time scale, geographical scale, partnership
- shared with WP1
- transfer into MS Access almost ready

Synergies with PLACARD | SPINE

Potential:

- use to add on to our own stakeholder database
- Add on to the SPINE (esp. Challenges 2 + 3 and sub- and supra-national initiatives (municipalities/cities, regions, transnational actors) to create a more mature joint product
- Use as a basis for ADB in WP4

Social Network Analysis

interaction between actors linked with DRR and CCA

Survey of 35 actors of SPINE, 32 answered

Cluster analysis will be visualized

Landscape visualization of actors in DRR and CCA

building on SNA and SPINE

Aim: Tool that will be useful for users

Challenge is to translate results (esp. SNA) into web-based format

Visualization of reports by clustering of terms

outputs of the SNA will be incorporated

→ challenge: Find a way of mapping that will not be a duplication

Synergies with PLACARD | SF

PLACARD offered to join the Brussels meeting in May in order to present their preliminary results, esp. their visualization of data

- potential starting point for discussions in the SF
- Need to structure it well to serve as a framing element

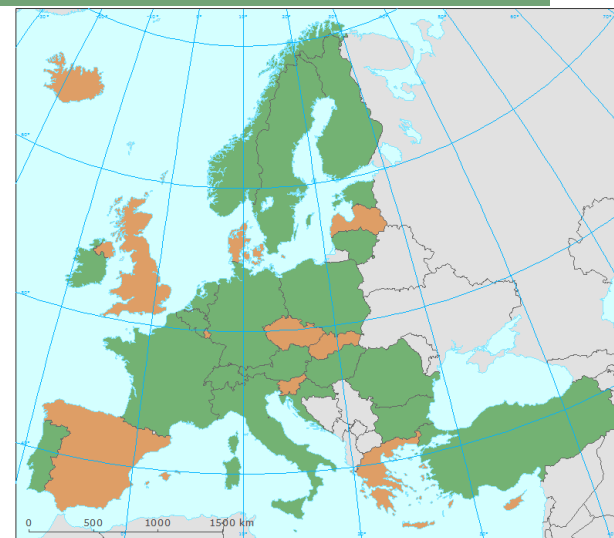

Preliminary data is available

Potential:

- Data from Qu 1 + 2 could feed into EU level report of Del. 2.1
- Q3 gives insights on stakeholder information requirements (Del 5.3)
(What specific topics could the report cover to support CCA/DRR activities at national or subnational level in your country?)

Answers:

- to include examples (case studies) from countries, regions and cities as well as outcomes from the past or ongoing (international) research and innovation projects.
- to identify of the most beneficial and effective solutions for both DRR + CCA
- to include examples of measures assessed against their respective cost-benefits ratio.
