## **1 INTRODUCTION**

The website has been on line since June 22, 2016 and is available at [www.espressoproject.eu](http://www.espressoproject.eu).

The website is based on Joomla, a free and open-source content management system (CMS) and application framework that powers 3% of the entire web.

## 2 ESPRESSO WEBSITE – PUBLIC AREA

As illustrated in Figure 1, there are four main areas in the website:

- the toolbar;
- an area with the scrolling images;
- a short introduction to the project.
